Literacy Activities

- **Practice** the *Spelling* words.
 - Take time every day to practice spelling.
 - Do your spelling test on **Tuesday, March 30**.
 - Remember your parents *are not allowed* to help.
 - Send a picture of your final test to your teacher on SeeSaw
- **Watch** the *Writing Week 2* video and spend 10 minutes writing.
 - 1 other time this week spend 10 minutes writing.
- **Watch** the *Reading Week 2 - Lesson 3* and *Lesson 4* videos and complete the accompanying assignments.
- 3 times this week, set up your **reading workshop centers** and spend 10 minutes at each: paper work, silent reading, technology (Raz Kids, Teach Me Grade 1 or any other educational app you have access to) and a game (any games you have access to that incorporate reading).
- Do some **Home-Shared Reading (Raz Kids)**.
 - Try to read at least one book each day and do the quiz that goes with it.
- **Watch** the *Read Aloud Week 2* video and answer the following questions:
 - Why was Papa making pastries?
 - What happened when he went to the villages to sell the pastries?
 - How did all the people that Papa showed kindness to help Papa's family in the end?
 - Write down 5 verbs from this story.

Numeracy Activities

- **Watch** the *Numeracy Lesson 3* video and spend 10 minutes at each math workshop center:
 - Hands on video activity
 - Math booklet (pencil work)
 - Technology (SplashLearn or any other educational app you have access to)
 - Game (any games you have access to that incorporate math - dice games, card games, etc.)
- **Practice** your Mad Minute at least 3 times this week.
 - Keep track of how long it takes you each time and see if you can pass the level by doing it in under a minute.
- **Watch** the *Numeracy Lesson 4* video and spend 10 minutes at each math workshop center:
 - Hands on video activity
 - Math booklet (pencil work)
 - Technology (SplashLearn or any other educational app you have access to)
 - Game (any games you have access to that incorporate math - dice games, card games, etc.)

Bible Activities

- Each day this week, **watch** a video and complete the activity that goes with it.

Unit Studies Activities

- **Watch** the *What Are Our Rights?* video.
 - Answer the shared reading questions.
 - Create your Rights flip book.
 - Create your mini book.
