

Weekly Proposed Schedule for Grade I

We would suggest that kids are engaging in literacy and numeracy each day. As we will not be posting a lesson for both areas each day, here are some other suggested activities that you can engage your children in.

- Daily **literacy** could look like this:
 - Practicing popcorn words by reading, spelling and using them in written sentences.
 - Practicing your Fry word bookmarks.
 - Practicing weekly spelling words in the same ways that you were doing at home before. Alternatively you could also practice them by building them with playdoh, stamping/stickers them out, tracing them in sugar or sand, making them out of wiki sticks, writing them in chalk, and writing them using different mediums like markers, crayons, typing, painting, etc.
 - Watching and completing the weekly literacy lessons that are posted.
 - Reading to self, to others, to pets, to video to send to your teacher, to stuffies.
 - Practicing reading on Raz Kids.
 - Watching and completing the reading, read aloud and writing lessons that are posted.
 - Writing a letter to a classmate or a letter to a classmate or a teacher about what you are doing at home, a story you have written etc.
 - If needed, practice printing with proper form. Use the Handwriting Heroes videos/app to engage the kids and/or printing practice pages included in your home packet.
 - Watching the weekly read aloud from Mrs. K or Miss Driedger and answering the questions that go with it.
- Daily **numeracy** could look like this:
 - Watching and completing the weekly lessons that we post online.
 - Practicing Mad Minutes.
 - Working through your math booklet.
 - Playing games with dice, cards, memory games etc.
 - Playing online math games (eg. SplashLearn) or Mad Minute practice.
 - Baking something and teach/engage your child in the measurement and time aspects of baking.

Each week we will upload the weekly learning plan with specific lessons and activities for that week. You are free to work through them and use them as works best for your family. Below you will see a schedule that incorporates all of the lessons for the week. Please do not feel pressured to follow it unless it is helpful.
